



## Instructions for attending Face to Face Services at Union Church of San Juan

1. Members and guests wishing to attend a Sunday Worship service must reserve their space(s) by calling the Administration office (Monday – Thursday) (787)726-0280 or by email: [office@unionchurchsj.org](mailto:office@unionchurchsj.org). No transportation services will be provided at this moment.
2. The use of Face masks is mandatory while within church premises and a minimum distance of 6 feet must be kept at all times from those that are not attending with you.
3. The gates of the building will open at 10:00AM. If you arrive earlier, you must wait in your car or outside.
4. Attendees MUST have their temperature taken. If your temperature is higher than 100.4°F or 38°C, you won't be allowed to enter the Sanctuary; you MUST use hand sanitizer at the "Shalom Table" (the Reception table just inside the front gate), and complete a COVID-19 safety survey.
5. There is a system to enter and exit the sanctuary. If you come with other family members you will be seated together, at least six feet distant from other worshippers. Children will remain with their parents at all times. You must remain in your assigned seat for all the duration of the service. At the end of the service you will exit as instructed.
6. If you need to use the restrooms, wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water and use the paper towel to open the doors that you encounter on your way back to the pews. Please inform an usher or the maintenance staff for proper sanitation after use.
7. There will be no congregational singing since this has been found to facilitate the spread of the virus.
8. There will be no Hospitality Table or Fellowship Time after worship. Everyone must exit the church premises at the end of the service.

Please stay home and contact your doctor if you have symptoms associated with COVID-19, if you have been in contact with someone with these associated symptoms, if you have traveled during the past two weeks, or have been in contact with anyone traveling.

If you don't want to follow this protocol then please wait until the pandemic subsides before you return to our face to face worship. **You can still participate via Facebook.**
